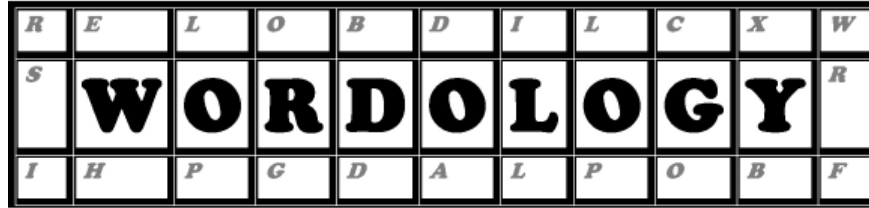

Wordology Activity #2: Heroes Crossword

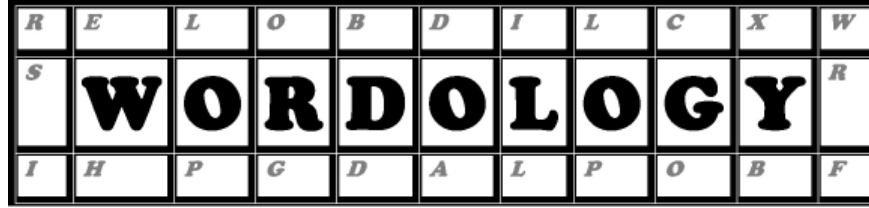

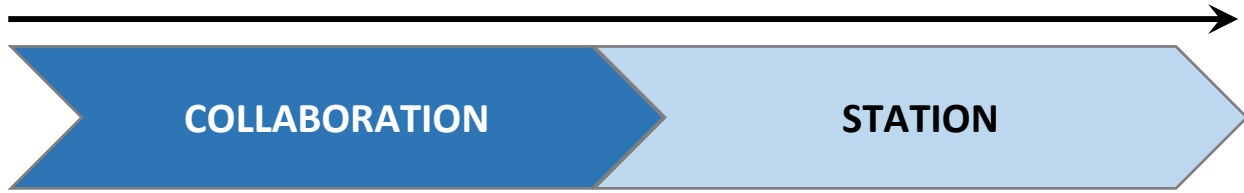
